Purpose and Justification:

An interview with Mr. Lapointe of 131 Crescent Ave., North Attleborough, MA was completed with the Town Manager. Christopher is a lifelong resident of North Attleborough and a graduate of North Attleborough High School. He served honorably in the United States Marine Corps for eight years, including a deployment to Iraq in the Al Asad area. He brings a younger veteran's perspective to the Veterans Advisory Board, which will be invaluable as we continue to engage and support our veteran community. Upon confirmation, I have challenged him to help us reach younger veterans in Town and to share his knowledge about the benefits and resources available to them. I believe that Mr. Lapointe's experience, commitment, and perspective make him well qualified to serve in this important role, and I enthusiastically recommend his appointment.

Therefore, I respectfully request the Town Council confirm the appointment of Christopher Lapointe to the Advisory Board to Veterans Services. Term to expire on 6/30/2026.
